About PCHP

The intractable "achievement gap" is the nation's most critical educational challenge. Forty percent of children in the United States, primarily low-income children, are not prepared for kindergarten. **The Parent-Child Home Program (PCHP) has been bridging the achievement gap by helping low-income families prepare their children for school success for over 45 years!** PCHP's evidence-based model utilizes intensive home visiting to reach families with two to four-year-olds who are challenged by poverty, isolation, language and literacy barriers, and limited educational opportunities.

- ▶ Raise awareness and support for PCHP through networking, social media marketing, and fundraising
- ▶ Plan and volunteer at enrichment activities for the children and families at PCHP sites
- ▶ Provide YPC members with opportunities to expand their professional networks and learn about non-profit service
